


Situation Monitoring & Assessment

CASE INVESTIGATION & CONTACT TRACING

- The parish health departments have investigated all confirmed cases.
- Traced 3,968 named contacts of the confirmed cases (as at 21st June 2020) and have surveyed several communities.
- Case investigations and contact tracing yielded 456 cases (69.2% of all confirmed cases).








Capacity Building
