REGIONAL FRAMEWORK OF TEACHING COMPETENCIES IN PUBLIC HEALTH WEBINAR 2024 - TOWARDS A NETWORK OF TEACHERS

In 2022, the Virtual Campus of Public Health (VCPH) of the Pan American Health Organization (PAHO) and the Association of Schools and Programs of Public Health (ASPPH) developed the Regional Framework of Teaching Competencies in Public Health (MRCDSP), with the purpose of having a regional tool that would serve as a guide to the training of public health teachers in the Region of the Americas.

Subsequently, the VCPH and the ASPPH developed an evaluation strategy for the MRCDSP, which includes a competency assessment module that has been piloted on 3 occasions. This initiative is the result of the collaboration of more than 1500 teachers from 21 countries in the Region, representing more than 100 institutions that are responsible for training a significant portion of the human resources in health in the Americas, at different levels and modalities

An outstanding collaborator in this initiative, among others, has been the Faculty of Nursing and Obstetrics of the National Autonomous University of Mexico. Together with the VCPH and the ASPPH, they organized an important webinar, aimed at consolidating and formalizing a network of teachers that has been articulated around this project.

This webinar has the following objectives:

- To share experiences from the evaluation process of the MRCDSP
- To promote synergies for the dissemination of the MRCDSP and its evaluation throughout the Region of the Americas
- To strengthen the network of teachers that has been formed around this project.
